

Pupil Premium Funding

Pupil premium funding is in addition to each school's budget. Every School decides how to allocate this funding to best support the raising of attainment for their most vulnerable pupils.

We use our Pupil Premium in different ways to achieve this:-

- The majority of identified pupils have made accelerated progress in their learning, a result of careful, targeted staffing that means all children, including those pupils that attract pupil premium funding, who were not on track to reach their targets, are in receipt of 1:1 or small group.
- Some pupils in receipt of pupil premium funding benefited from improved self-esteem, with positive impact on learning, after Best Start family support and intervention.
- As an inclusive school, of course, we do have children who have additional needs beyond learning. To ensure that all children can learn in a calm, safe atmosphere some of our pupil premium money has been spent on an additional TA who works on behaviour modification strategies where necessary.
- Specific training in Behaviour Strategies for TA.
- Pupils can access out of school enrichment activities.
- The school plans to continue with these strategies during the next academic year
